



Idaho SWE Scholarships

What are SWE Scholarships?

The Society of Women Engineers (SWE) is a national organization that aims to encourage women to enter engineering. The Southwest Idaho SWE section offers merit-based scholarships to women from *anywhere* in Idaho planning to pursue a degree in engineering, or another STEM field such as Computer Science, math or a hard science. The number of scholarships and amounts vary each year depending on donations. Since the program's inception in 1995, Southwest Idaho SWE has raised more than \$255,000 benefitting more than 135 Idaho High-School women.

Who are they for?

Women residing in the state of Idaho entering their first year of an ABET accredited program may submit an application. Students must prove that they will be attending a 4- or 5-year engineering school (accredited by ABET, Accredited Board of Engineering and Technology) in the year that the scholarship is received. The college does not need to be located in Idaho. Minimum GPA requirement is 3.0.

The most important consideration for selection is an essay submitted by the applicant written about her desire to enter an engineering or engineering-related field and why that particular field interests her. The essay should be a **maximum of 1000 words**, double spaced and **not** mention financial need. Please have the applicant's name at the top or bottom of every page of the essay. The essay should be inventive and tell the story of her path to choosing engineering. It should include the following:

- What inspired her to choose engineering
- What has she done to prepare herself for the field of engineering
- What kinds of activities she has undertaken to explore engineering as a career choice

The Scholarship Committee will also consider the applicant's academic achievements, (emphasizing math and science), and extracurricular activities and accomplishments.

How do I apply?

Online application submission begins December 1, 2021. The applications must be completed and **submitted via our website no later than midnight on January 31, 2022**. Applicants will be notified of the results through email by April 1, 2022. Scholarship checks will be issued directly to the student after receiving proof of college registration in an ABET program.
